TUHH is one of the newest and most successful universities of technology in Germany.

It was founded in 1978 with the aim of promoting structural change in the region. Today, 100 professors and around 1,200 employees (of whom 614 are research associates, including third-party funded positions) work at the TUHH. With approximately 7,300 students, there is a healthy staff/student ratio.

Plenty of meeting places on campus provide the opportunity for fruitful dialogue and exchanging ideas. The atmosphere can simply be described as youthful, innovative, unconventional, original and creative – ideal for developing new ideas in engineering. This is how TUHH has become northern Germany's

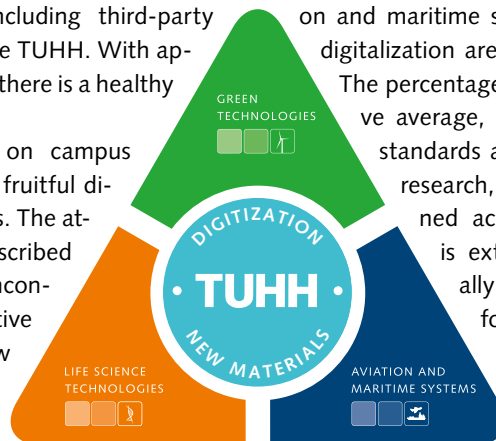
ideas factory for science and technology, making it not just an architectural gem for Harburg, but also the heart of Hamburg's innovative future. Fresh

The percentage of research funding is well above average, which is testament to our high standards and international profile. Besides research, the teaching concept is designed according to the latest methods, is externally evaluated and continually improved via our own Center for Teaching and Learning (ZLL).

With this systematic format of continual development and improvement, TUHH has once again made an impact

on the German higher education landscape. Since its founding, TUHH's leitmotif has been to develop "Technology for Humankind".
